- \* LB 126 (*Day*) Change provisions relating to homestead exemptions and property assessment and tax rolls

- \* LB 388e (*Linehan*) Adopt the Property Tax Growth Limitation Act, the Advertising Services Tax Act, and the Property Tax Relief Act and change provisions relating to revenue and taxation
