Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Bill Summary:

A school board is mandated to allow a student concurrently enrolled in a private, denominational, or non-accredited school, or one that opts not to meet accreditation requirements, to attend part-time without charge in the school district for the sole purpose of participating in extracurricular activities, as outlined in section 79-2,136. This provision applies if the student or at least one parent of the student resides in a neighboring school district, and the district of residence does not provide the specific extracurricular activity the student wishes to engage in through part-time



enrollment.
