Explanation of Estimate:

LB 1373 adopts the Dietitian Licensure Compact and changes provisions relating to criminal background checks. As of July 1, 2023, Nebraska had 793 licensed Medical Nutrition Therapists. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) would be responsible for issuing multi-state licenses for Nebraska home state Medical Nutrition Therapists only when requested by applicant. DHHS would be responsible for keeping track of out of state Medical Nutrition Therapists practicing in Nebraska under compact privileges issued in another member state.

Licensing rules and regulations are currently being updated to implement the 2023 revisions to the Medical Nutrition Therapy Act. The Board of Medical Nutrition Therapy and Division are currently drafting regulations that align with the changes under Nebraska Revised Statute (Neb. Rev. Stat.) §§ 38-1801 to 38-1822. The regulation drafting specifically focuses on the requirements for 3 new license types – licensed dietitian nutritionist, licensed nutritionist, and a temporary license to practice medical nutrition therapy. These changes will align with the language of LB 1373.

LB 1373 would require DHHS to make minor changes to rules and regulations; make modifications to the licensure software system; create data sets for information exchanges; application form changes; DHHS website information changes and provide a delegate employee to serve on the Dietitian Licensure Compact Commission.

All costs associated with implementing and administering multi-state licenses for Dieticians and participating in the Dietitian Licensure Compact Commission will be recovered under the Uniform Credentialing Act Sections 38-151 through 38-156 administrative costs and fees. Additional costs incurred to provide criminal background checks would be passed along to the applicants.
