

AMENDMENTS TO LB1188

Introduced by Business and Labor.

1 1. Strike the original sections and insert the following new
2 sections:

3 Section 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as may be
4 required, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund or from other
5 funds as indicated in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for
6 the payment of an indemnification claim that has been settled by the
7 State Claims Board and approved by the district court, that has been
8 settled by the Attorney General in the district court, or in which a
9 court judgment has been entered and that requires the approval of the
10 Legislature for payment.

11 \$100,000.00 for Indemnification Claim No. CI 20-918 against the
12 State of Nebraska, pay to Trust Account of Rehm, Moore and Rehm P.C.
13 L.L.O., 3701 Union Drive, Number 200, Lincoln, Nebraska 68516, out of the
14 General Fund.

15 The claim included in this section shall be paid through Program 592
16 in Agency 65.

24 Sec. 2. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be
25 required, are hereby appropriated from the General Fund or from other
26 funds as indicated in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for

1 the Attorney General in the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court or in
2 which court judgments have been entered and which require the approval of
3 the Legislature for payment.

4 \$140,000.00 for a workers' compensation claim, pay to [**ANNUITY
5 COMPANY**], on behalf of Landis Johnson, out of the Workers' Compensation
6 Claims Revolving Fund.

7 \$70,000.00 for a workers' compensation claim, pay to Atwood,
8 Holsten, Brown, Deaver, Spier and Israel Law Firm, P.C. L.L.O., 575
9 Fallbrook Boulevard, Suite 206, Lincoln, Nebraska 68521, on behalf of
10 Landis Johnson, out of the Workers' Compensation Claims Revolving Fund.

11 \$350,000.00 for a workers' compensation claim, pay to Dowding,
12 Dowding, Dowding, and Urbom, 201 North 8th Street, Suite 242, Lincoln,
13 Nebraska 68501, on behalf of Santino Madut Akot.

14 The claims included in this section shall be paid through Program
15 593 in Agency 65.

23 Sec. 3. The Director of Administrative Services is hereby
24 authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the funds in the
25 state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of the several
26 beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set opposite their
27 respective names, upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The
28 several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any
29 and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every
30 character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its

1 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with
2 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
3 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
4 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
5 releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and
6 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
7 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
8 hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out
9 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.
