- 3 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
- 4 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
- 5 releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and
- 6 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
- 7 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
- 8 hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out
- 9 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.
