Introduced by Riepe, 12.

1 1. Strike the original sections and all amendments thereto and
2 insert the following new sections:

3 Section 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as may be
4 required, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund or from other
5 funds as indicated in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for
6 the payment of an indemnification claim that has been settled by the
7 State Claims Board and approved by the district court, that has been
8 settled by the Attorney General in the district court, or in which a
9 court judgment has been entered and that requires the approval of the
10 Legislature for payment.

11 \$100,000.00 for Indemnification Claim No. CI 20-918 against the
12 State of Nebraska, pay to Trust Account of Rehm, Moore and Rehm, P.C.,

27 Sec. 4. The Director of Administrative Services is hereby
28 authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the funds in the
29 state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of the several
30 beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set opposite their

1 respective names, upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The
2 several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any
3 and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every
4 character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its
5 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with
6 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
7 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
8 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
9 releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and
10 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
11 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
12 hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out
13 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.
