Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1118 would require the city council to be an additional party that consents to an officer's removal, as conducted by the mayor in cities of the second class.

Section-by-Section Summary:

Section 1 amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 17-107 to require consent of both the mayor and the city council in removal of municipal officers. This statute applies to cities of the second class.

Section 2 repeals the original sections.
