AN ACT to amend section 79-466, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to schools; to provide that no member of a board of education shall be employed as a teacher in the district in which he resides; to provide an exception; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-466, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-466. No person-holding-a-school-district office member of a board of education shall be employed to-teach-in as a teacher by the school district of-which he-is-an-officer on which board he serves: Provided. this section shall not apply to a part-time county superintendent who by law serves on a board of education.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-466, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
