

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 524

Approved by the Governor April 26, 1971

Introduced by Richard F. Proud, 12th District; P. J. Morgan, 4th District

AN ACT to amend section 79-521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to schools; to provide for proceeds of sale of school property of Class III, IV, and VI schools as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-521. No school property of any kind, belonging to any school district of the third, fourth, or sixth class, shall be sold by the board of education except at a regular meeting of the same, and not then without an affirmative recorded vote of at least two-thirds of all the members of the board. Proceeds of sale of school property, sold as above provided, may be held separately from other funds of the school district and may be used for any school purpose as the board of education may determine, including, but not limited to, acquiring sites for school buildings or teacherages and purchasing existing buildings for use as school buildings or teacherages, including the sites upon which such buildings are located, and the erection, alteration, equipping and furnishing of school buildings or teacherages.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
