

LEGISLATIVE BILL 44

AN ACT to amend section 79-1521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the school retirement system; to provide for mandatory retirement of school employees as prescribed; to provide exceptions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-1521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-1521. Any member in service who attains or shall have attained the age of sixty-five years shall be retired forthwith from active duty as a school employee; Provided, that, with the approval of his employer, given from year to year, he may remain in service after he attains the age of sixty-five years until the attainment of age seventy-two; and provided further, that such member shall make no further deposits in the School Employees' Savings Fund as provided in section 79-1531, nor shall he receive further credit toward any service annuity.

The provision for mandatory retirement at age seventy-two shall not apply to elected officials.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-1521, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
