LEGISLATIVE BILL 503

Passed over the Governor's veto April 9, 1990.

AN ACT relating to state constitutional officers; to amend sections 84-101.01, 84-201.01, and 84-721, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 75-104, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1988; to change the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Auditor of Public Accounts, State Treasurer, and Attorney General and of members of the Public Service Commission as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 75-104, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1988, be amended to read as follows:

75-104. Commencing January 8, 1987, the The salary of each commissioner shall be thirty-five thousand dollars. Commencing January 3, 1991, the each commissioner shall be forty-two thousand dollars. In addition thereto, the commissioners, secretary, clerks, and other employees of the commission shall be entitled to receive from the state their actual necessary traveling expenses, which shall include the cost of transportation while traveling on the business of the commission, to be paid in the same manner as other requests for payment or reimbursement from the state. In computing the cost of transportation for the commissioners, secretary, clerks, and other employees, no mileage or other traveling expense shall be requested or allowed unless sections 81-1174 to 81-1177 are strictly complied with.

Sec. 2. That section 84-101.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

84-101.01. The Governor shall receive an annual salary of forty thousand dollars. Commencing January 8, 1987, the salary of the Governor shall be fifty-eight thousand dollars. Commencing January 3. 1991, the annual salary of the Governor shall be sixty-five thousand dollars. Such salary shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

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Sec. 3. That section 84-201.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

84-201.01. The Attorney General shall receive an annual salary of fifty-seven thousand five hundred dollars. Commencing January 3, 1991, the annual salary of the Attorney General shall be sixty-four thousand five hundred dollars. Commencing the first Thursday after the first Tuesday in January 1979, there shall be paid as salary to the Attorney General the sum of thirty-nine thousand five hundred dollars. The salary of the Attorney General shall be payable in equal monthly installments. Commencing January 8, 1987, the salary of the Attorney General shall be fifty-seven thousand five hundred dollars.

Sec. 4. That section 84-721, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

84-721. Commencing the first Thursday after the first Tuesday in January 1979; there shall be paid as salaries to certain constitutional officers as follows: Secretary of State, the sum of thirty-two thousand dollars per annum; Auditor of Public Accounts; the sum of thirty-two thousand dollars per annum; State Treasurer, the sum of thirty-two thousand dollars per annum, and the bieutenant Governor, the sum of thirty-two thousand dollars per annum- Beginning January 8, 1987, there There shall be paid as salaries certain constitutional officers as to follows: Secretary of State, the sum of forty thousand dollars per annum; Auditor of Public Accounts, the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars per annum; State Treasurer, the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars per annum; and the Lieutenant Governor, the sum of forty thousand dollars per annum. Commencing January 3, 1991, there shall be paid as salaries to certain constitutional officers as follows: Secretary of State, the sum of fifty-two thousand dollars per year; Auditor of Public Accounts, the sum of forty-nine thousand five hundred dollars per year; State Treasurer, the sum of forty-nine thousand five hundred dollars per year; and Lieutenant Governor, the sum of forty-seven thousand dollars per year. Such salaries shall be payable in equal installments.

Sec. 5. That original sections 84-101.01, 84-201.01, and 84-721, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and section 75-104, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1988, are repealed.
