Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB1199 is a clean-up bill. The bill removes reference to section 33-105, which directs that fees be paid and collected on certain filings. LB1199, then outright repeals section 33-105 in its entirety. Section 33-105, is entitled: "Department of Natural Resource Fees." The fees are for filing and having reviewed various small fees which are minimal compared to the cost of collection, LB1199 removes them.

Chapter 46 of Nebraska statute concerns "Irrigation and Regulation of water in Nebraska". LB1199 eliminates the applicability of definitions found in chapter 46 to Natural Resource fees by deleting section 33-105.
