**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB923 would allow tribal enrollment cards to be used as proof of age and identity for certain purposes.

Section 1 would amend 28-1202.03 would allow a person lawfully carrying a concealed handgun to satisfy the requirement to carry an identification document by carrying a tribal enrollment card.

Section 2 would amend 53-167.02 to include tribal enrollment cards in the list of acceptable identification documents required for purchasing kegs of alcohol.

Section 3 would amend 53-180.06 to include tribal enrollment cards in the list of acceptable identification documents



required for purchasing alcohol.

Section 4 would amend 69-2404 to include tribal enrollment cards in the list of acceptable identification documents required for a handgun transfer certificate.

Section 5 would amend 69-2430 to include tribal enrollment cards in the list of acceptable identification documents required for an application for a permit to carry a concealed handgun.
