

LEGISLATIVE BILL 1305

Approved by the Governor April 8, 1972

Introduced by P. J. Morgan, 4th District

AN ACT to amend section 43-238, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to juvenile courts; to provide for the speedy adjudication of appeals to the Supreme Court when parental rights are severed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 43-238, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

43-238. Any final order or judgment entered by a separate juvenile court may be reviewed by the Supreme Court of Nebraska within the same time and in the same manner prescribed by law for review of an order or judgment of the district court; Provided, that when appeal is taken from a finding by the juvenile court severing parental rights, the cause shall be advanced for argument before the Supreme Court, and the Supreme Court shall, in order to expedite the preferred disposition of the case and the child, render the judgment and write an opinion as speedily as possible.

Sec. 2. That original section 43-238, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
