

LEGISLATIVE BILL 210

Approved by the Governor February 22, 1971

Introduced by Wayne W. Ziebarth, 37th District; Ramey C. Whitney, 44th District; Thomas C. Kennedy, 21st District; Harold D. Simpson, 46th District

AN ACT to amend sections 79-202 and 79-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to schools; to conform a provision on attendance to other legislation; to change procedures for filing attendance reports; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-202, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-202. Section 79-201 shall not apply where the child is physically or mentally incapacitated for the work done in the school, or in any case where the services or earnings of a child, who is fourteen years or more of age and has completed the work of the eighth grade, are necessary for his own support or the support of those actually dependent upon him, or when illness or severe weather conditions make attendance impossible or impracticable.

Sec. 2. That section 79-207, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-207. Each teacher in the public, private, denominational, and parochial schools of this state shall keep a record showing (1) the name, age, and address of each child enrolled, (2) the number and county of the school district in which said school is located, (3) the number of days each pupil was present and the number of days absent, and (4) the cause of absence. On the third day on which the public, private, denominational, and parochial schools are in session at the beginning of each school year, each teacher in a Class I district shall send to the county superintendent a list of the pupils enrolled in his school with the age, grade, and address of each, ~~except that in cities of the metropolitan and first class~~ and in all other districts such report shall be made to the superintendent of ~~the city schools of~~ such district.
