

LEGISLATIVE BILL 218

Approved by the Governor February 22, 1971

Introduced by Wayne W. Ziebarth, 37th District; Ramey C. Whitney, 44th District; Thomas C. Kennedy, 21st District; Harold D. Simpson, 46th District

AN ACT relating to schools; to require the display of the flags of the United States and of the State of Nebraska, as prescribed; and to repeal sections 79-4,128 to 79-4,132, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The flags of the United States of America and of the State of Nebraska shall be prominently displayed on the school grounds of every public school in the state on each day that such school is in session, in accordance with the standards prescribed for the display of the flag of the United States of America. For the purposes of this act, public school shall mean all institutions of learning supported in whole or in part by public funds, including those providing post-high school education.

Sec. 2. The governing body of each school shall provide suitable flags and flagstuffs to carry out the provisions of this act, and the cost of such flags and flagstuffs shall be paid from the general operating funds of each school.

Sec. 3. That sections 79-4,128 to 79-4,132, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
