

LEGISLATIVE BILL 528

Approved by the Governor April 1, 1971

Introduced by Willard H. Waldo, 31st District; Jerome Warner, 25th District; Gerald A. Stromer, 36th District

AN ACT relating to schools; to require the county superintendent to assign a distinct number as prescribed.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The county superintendent of each county shall assign a distinct number to each school district within the county. School district numbers presently in use shall not be changed except as hereinafter provided. No number shall be assigned that is in excess of three digits. A number previously assigned to a school district shall not be reassigned as long as there is outstanding bonded indebtedness incurred by the district which was originally assigned that number. A number shall be assigned to each joint school district by the county superintendent of the county in which the administrative offices of the joint district are located.
