

LEGISLATIVE BILL 429

Approved by the Governor April 9, 1973

Introduced by Nore, 22

AN ACT to amend section 79-439, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, relating to schools; to provide for school board meetings as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-439, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

79-439. In all meetings of any school board, or board of education, a majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Regular meetings shall be held on the first or before the second Monday of every month. All meetings of the board shall be subject to the provisions of sections 84-1401 to 84-1405. Special meetings may be called by the president or any two members, but all members shall have notice of the time and place of meeting; Provided, the provisions of sections 79-439 to 79-444 shall not apply to Class V districts.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-439, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1972, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
