

LEGISLATIVE BILL 565

AN ACT relating to navigable streams; to authorize the
people of the state to have access by boat to
any cutoff, chute, backwater, or bayou
connected with any navigable stream in
Nebraska as prescribed.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. To further implement the provisions
of Article XV, section 5, of the Constitution of
Nebraska, the Legislature herewith provides that the
people of the state shall have access by boat to any
cutoff, chute, backwater, or bayou connected with any
navigable stream located in the State of Nebraska, but
that nothing in this section shall serve to allow
trespass upon the lands of any person.
