

LEGISLATIVE BILL 589

Approved by the Governor May 25, 1973

Introduced by Froud, 12

AN ACT to amend section 71-193.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to public health; to set the age qualification for dental hygiene practice at eighteen; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 71-193.04 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

71-193.04. Any person (1) of good moral character, (2) who is a graduate of an accredited high school or its equivalent, and (3) who is also a graduate of a training school for dental hygienists that is approved by the Board of Examiners in Dentistry and that requires a course of not less than two academic years may, upon payment of the fee prescribed in section 71-162, be examined by such board on the subjects considered essential by it for a dental hygienist. Such examination may, in the discretion of the board, be conducted by a part of the members of such board. If the applicant, in the opinion of the board, successfully passes such examination, he shall be entitled to be licensed as a dental hygienist if he has attained the age of eighteen years, notwithstanding any provision of section 71-193.

Sec. 2. That original section 71-193.04, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
