## LEGISLATIVE BILL 140

AN ACT to amend section 39-669.12, Revised Statutes
Supplement, 1974, relating to the implied
consent law; to provide the status of those
withdrawing blood at the request of an
officer; to provide for liability and
immunity; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-669.12, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1974, be amended to read as follows:

or qualified technician, or hospital shall be held tiable, in-damages or otherwise, -for-any-act-done-or omitted-in an agent of the State of Nebraska when performing the act of withdrawing blood at the request of a law enforcement officer pursuant to section 39-669.08. The physician, registered nurse, rualified technician, or hospital shall not be individually liable in damages or otherwise for any act done or omitted in performing the act of withdrawing blood at the request of a law enforcement officer pursuant to section 39-669.08, except for acts of iross neitlinese of the agent or of persons employed by such agent.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-669.12, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1974, is repealed.
