AN ACT to amend section 76-216, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to conveyances; to change provisions relating to acknowledgment requirements; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 76-216, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

76-216. The grantor must acknowledge the instrument ~~to-be-his--voluntary--act--and--deed~~ with an acknowledgment as defined in section 64-205.

Sec. 2. That original section 76-216, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
