

LEGISLATIVE BILL 120

Approved by the Governor February 27, 1981

Introduced by Burrows, 30

AN ACT to amend section 25-2165, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to writs of mandamus; to provide for the recovery of attorney's fees as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 25-2165, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

25-2165. If judgment be given for the plaintiff, he or she shall recover the damages which he or she shall have sustained, to be ascertained by the court or a jury, or by referees, in a civil action, ~~and~~ costs, and reasonable attorney fees; and a peremptory mandamus shall also be granted to him or her without delay.

Sec. 2. That original section 25-2165, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
