

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 99

Approved by the Governor May 15, 1981

Introduced by Beutler, 28; Hoagland, 6

AN ACT to amend sections 26-112, 33-123, and 33-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to courts; to change fees as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 26-112, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

26-112. The clerk of the municipal court shall charge and receive the following fees:

(1) In civil matters: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action, ten fourteen dollars; for all orders after judgment, including, but not limited to, writs of execution, restitution, garnishment, examination in aid of execution, taking and approving any recognizance or bond, and furnishing transcripts, ~~one-dollar~~ three dollars each; and

(2) In criminal matters: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action, and the issuance of mittimus or discharge to the jailer, six ten dollars; except that in all cases handled by a violations bureau established by the local governing body by ordinance, under the jurisdiction of the municipal court, the court cost shall be as set forth in such ordinance; and for all orders and all services rendered after judgment, including, but not limited to, entries and official acts recorded, furnishing transcripts, and taking and approving any recognizance or bond, ~~one-dollar~~ three dollars each.

Sec. 2. That section 33-123, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-123. The county court shall be entitled to the following fees in civil matters: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action, ten fourteen dollars; for all orders, after judgment, including writs of execution, restitution, garnishment, examination in aid of

execution, and taking and approving any recognizance or bond, ~~one-dollar~~ three dollars each.

Sec. 3. That section 33-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

33-124. In criminal matters including preliminary and juvenile hearings, the county judge shall receive the following fees: For any and all services rendered up to and including the judgment or dismissal of the action and the issuance of mittimus or discharge to the jailer, the sum of ~~six~~ ten dollars; for all orders after judgment and taking and approving any recognizance or bond, ~~one-dollar~~ three dollars each.

Sec. 4. That original sections 26-112, 33-123, and 33-124, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
