

LEGISLATIVE BILL 229

Approved by the Governor April 11, 1984

Introduced by Beutler, 28

AN ACT relating to libraries; to amend section 51-214, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to money recovered in civil actions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 51-214, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

51-214. Penalties imposed or accruing by any ~~by-law~~ bylaw or regulation of the library board and any court costs and attorney's fees may be recovered in a civil action before any in county court having jurisdiction, such action to be instituted in the name of the library board of the city, village, county, or township. Money, other than any court costs and attorney's fees, collected in such actions shall be forthwith placed in the treasury of the city, village, township, or county to the credit of the city, village, township, or county library fund. Attorney's fees collected pursuant to this section shall be placed in the treasury of the city, village, or county and credited to the budget of the city, village, or county attorney's office. All attorney's fees collected on behalf of a township shall be paid over to the county treasury and credited to the budget of the county attorney's office.

Sec. 2. That original section 51-214, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
