

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 51

Approved by the Governor February 15, 1985

Introduced by Chronister, 18

AN ACT relating to change of boundaries; to amend section 17-419, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change a provision relating to vacation of a plat; and to repeal the original section.  
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 17-419, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

17-419. Any such plat may be vacated after approval of the governing body by the proprietors thereof, at any time before the sale of any lots therein, by a written instrument declaring the same to be vacated. Such written instrument shall be approved by the governing body and shall be duly executed, acknowledged or proved, and recorded in the same office with the plat to be vacated. The execution and recording of such writing shall operate to destroy the force and effect of the recording of the plat so vacated; and to divest all public rights in the streets, alleys, commons, and public grounds laid out or described in such plat. In cases ~~where~~ when any lots have been sold, the plat may be vacated, as herein provided, by all the owners of lots in such plat joining in the execution of the writing aforesaid.

Sec. 2. That original section 17-419, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
