

LEGISLATIVE BILL 962

Approved by the Governor March 17, 1988

Introduced by Warner, 25

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska State Capitol Environs Protection and Improvement Act; to amend section 90-301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to provide for the appointment of members to a board or commission as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 90-301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

90-301. Sections 90-301 to 90-305 and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska State Capitol Environs Protection and Improvement Act.

Sec. 2. The Governor may appoint members to a board or commission which is formed by the city of Lincoln or the county of Lancaster or both governmental bodies to protect and improve the Nebraska State Capitol environs.

Sec. 3. That original section 90-301, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
