

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 220

Approved by the Governor February 26, 1991

Introduced by Warner, 25

AN ACT relating to the Clerk of the Legislature; to amend section 49-1485, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to the furnishing of statements filed by lobbyists and summaries of the statements; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 49-1485, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

49-1485. The clerk shall, monthly while the Legislature is in session, and at least once while the Legislature is not in session, prepare a summary of the statements filed pursuant to section 49-1483 and, upon request, furnish each any member of the Legislature and members any member of the press, registered with the Legislature, a copy of any summary, of such statements filed pursuant to this section. Each statement shall be public information. The clerk shall furnish and a copy of each shall be furnished to each any statement, upon request, to any member of the Legislature and to members any member of the press, registered with the Legislature, at their request.

Sec. 2. That original section 49-1485, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
