

LEGISLATIVE BILL 93

Approved by the Governor March 21, 1995

Introduced by Bromm, 23

AN ACT relating to cities of the second class; to amend section 17-105, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to city council meetings and voting; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 17-105, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

17-105. Regular meetings of the city council shall be held at such times as the council may provide by ordinance. A majority of all the members elected to the council shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business, but a fewer number may adjourn from time to time and compel the attendance of absent members. Unless a greater vote is required by law, an affirmative vote of at least one-half of the elected members shall be required for the transaction of any business.

Sec. 2. Original section 17-105, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
