

LEGISLATIVE BILL 74

Approved by the Governor March 16, 2000

Introduced by Chambers, 11

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend sections 60-672 and 60-688, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to traffic infractions; to redefine a term; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-672, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

60-672. Traffic infraction shall mean the violation of any provision of the Nebraska Rules of the Road or of any law, ordinance, order, rule, or regulation regulating traffic which is not otherwise declared to be a misdemeanor or a felony. ~~and which shall be a civil offense.~~

Sec. 2. Section 60-688, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

60-688. Prosecutions for violations declared by the Nebraska Rules of the Road to be misdemeanors or felonies shall be conducted and disposed of in the same manner as provided for such prosecutions under the laws of this state, and traffic infractions shall be treated in the same manner as misdemeanors, except as otherwise provided by law.

Sec. 3. Original sections 60-672 and 60-688, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
