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STATUTORY AUTHORITY:

The Nebraska State Racing Commission statutory authority comes from Nebraska Revised Statutes Chapter 2, Sections 1201 through 1247. These Statutes also allow the Racing Commission to promulgate rules according to Administrative Rules Title 294.

Live horseracing, conducted in accordance with statutory requirements and administrative rules, provides a significant market for agricultural products and horse breeding operations. Facilities developed for and supported by live horseracing are also utilized for fairs, livestock shows, horse shows, farm equipment shows, and many other events and activities that support agriculture and community activities. Licensing of horseracing facilities and annual approval of live racing dates at these locations is the responsibility of the Nebraska Racing Commission. Criteria for approval of live racing dates are set forth in Administrative Rules, Title 294, Chapter 2, Section 2.005. The mission of the Racing Commission is to support and encourage agriculture and horse breeding by maximizing live racing opportunities that can be conducted consistent with statutory requirements and administrative rules.

Statutory incentives for horse breeding in Nebraska include criteria for **Nebraska-bred** horses (Neb. Rev. Stat. Chapter 2, Article 12, § 2-1213(2)), funding of purse supplements and breeder and stallion awards (§ 2-1207 (2), § 2-1207.01, and § 2-1213(1)), and a requirement for one race each race day limited to Nebraska-bred horses (§ 2-1213(1)). Statutory provisions authorize the Racing Commission to appoint official registrars for the purpose of registration and to certify eligibility of Nebraska-bred horses in accordance with procedures set forth in Administrative Rules, Title 294, Chapter 24. The Nebraska Thoroughbred Breeders Association Inc. has been appointed official registrar for Thoroughbred horses, and the Racing Commission serves as registrar for Quarter Horses. The mission of the Racing Commission is to promote horse breeding in Nebraska by ensuring proper administration and enforcement of Nebraska-bred statutory incentives.

To ensure the continuing viability of the horseracing industry in Nebraska, the legislature has authorized Nebraska Racing Commission licensing of **simulcast facilities at racetracks** licensed to conduct live horseracing, and authorized Racing Commission approval of intrastate and interstate simulcasting of horse races subject to statutory restrictions that protect the continuation of live horseracing. (Neb. Rev. Stat. Chapter 2, Article 12, § 2-1224 through § 2-1228).

VISION:

Support and encourage agriculture and horse breeding in Nebraska, utilizing authority and resources authorized by the legislature and approved by the governor. To prevent and eliminate corrupt practices in horseracing and pari-mutuel wagering. To maintain a high level of integrity and honesty in the horseracing industry and to ensure and promote the safety of racing participants and horses. To receive and disburse funds pursuant to statutory requirements.

MISSION AND PRINCIPLES:

The Nebraska Racing Commission mission is statewide regulation of the horseracing industry so as to ensure a level playing field for owners, trainers, and jockeys; to promote and ensure the health and safety of the humans and equines as it relates to their participation in the racing industry; to protect the public by ensuring the integrity of pari-mutuel wagering; and to exercise authority consistent with statutory and administrative requirements that provide due process and protect the rights of all persons subject to its jurisdiction.

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GOALS:

2017-2019 Biennium

The Nebraska State Racing Commission goals for the 2015-2017 biennium are:

- 1) Restore critical regulatory activities
- 2) Implement new regulatory activities, that are most essential to the mission of the Racing Commission
- 3) Identify and implement strategies to promote and enhance the live horseracing and the horse breeding industries.

Increase the occupational licensing fees. This is currently a proposed rule change that has been approved but need final approval.

Maintain the current post-race drug testing program. Currently the Commission is testing every horse that finishes first and second and collecting and testing an additional three random samples a day. Below are additional goals for FY17-19:

- Implement blood doping and CO2 testing. Currently, these topics are widely abused in horseracing and are a major national issue in our sport. Increase monitoring of practicing veterinarians who examine and treat horses registered for racing, and trainers who administer drugs provided or prescribed by veterinarians.
- Increase investigative staff.
- Backside and track transportation for the state veterinarian and investigators.
- Test barn and backside security video monitoring equipment.
- New equipment for the test barn.
- An additional metal detector for screening jockeys
- Hire a backup person for the licensing office.
- Develop an out of competition testing program

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY, MGMT PROCESSES, AND SERVICE DELIVERY METHODS:

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The Commission is a cash funded agency. The Commission receives .64 of one percent of the pari-mutuel wagering. This accounts for the majority of the Commissions revenue. In 2014, the amount wagered was \$68,027,588 and in 2015 \$69,301,184 was wagered. The Commission received \$435,376.56 in 2014 and \$443,527.58 in 2015. The Commission did see a slight increase in handle and revenue in 2015 over 2014. But the handle in 2014 showed a decline of approximately \$10,000,000.

The Commission also receives all licensing fees. These fees are broken down in NSRC Rule 10.007. In 2014, 1,410 licenses were issued and in 2015, 1,402 licenses were issued.

The Commission also receives \$50.00 for live race days, which ran at each pari-mutuel facility. In 2014 the amount collected was \$2,600 and in 2015, \$2,600 was collected. In 2016 the industry increased the number of race days by 2. But in 2012 there were ninety live race days.

The Commission projects the pari-mutuel handle for FY17 \$66,000,000 for FY18 \$65,000,000 and for FY19 \$62,000,000. These projected decreases will significantly affect the revenue of the Commission.

The Commission projects that the number of licenses to be issued in FY17, FY18 and FY19 will decrease. The Commission also projects that the pari-mutuel licensing fees will decrease.

The Commission is currently in the rule making process to increase racing occupational license fees by \$5. This is projected to increase revenue by approximately \$7,500.

The Commission is facing increased cheating and rule violations as a result in the economic times facing racing.

The Commission has reduced the hours that the licensing office is open, has made the Commission Veterinarian position a contract employee and has reduced the veterinarians position from five days a week to four days a week. (Do not have the Commission Veterinarian working on Wednesday's, which is an entry day for horses). The Commission has reduced the investigative staff from full time to part-time employees.

All these cuts hurt the Commission statutory duty in protecting the integrity of racing. The lack of regulation hurts the public who wager on these horses.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Racing Commission carries out its mission as authorized by State Statutes under a single agency program titled Enforcement of Standards. The Racing Commission is cash funded entirely by fees collected from the Racing Industry. In addition to its operations funding, the Racing Commission collects payments from all racetracks pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes 2-2108.04 and disburses the funds collected to recipient tracks defined by statute. The purpose of this pass through funding is to promote horseracing, breeding, and supplement purses at smaller tracks.

The Racing Commission

- 1) Enforces state laws and rules adopted by the Racing Commission through investigations and administrative hearings, and maintains ongoing working relationships with federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies.
- 2) Licenses racing industry participants, officials, mutuel employees, concessionaires, security personnel, and other track employees.
- 3) Obtains fingerprints from licensed applicants and checks criminal history at the state and federal level.
- 4) Prescribes and enforces security provisions and prohibitions against misconduct and corrupt practices.
- 5) Participates in the officiating of horseracing, the review and approval of officials employed by the racetracks, and monitoring the performance of officials during live racing.
- 6) Employs an official veterinarian to monitor the conditions of horses, to oversee practicing veterinarians who work at the tracks, and obtain samples from horses participating in races for testing.
- 7) Prescribes chemical testing to determine if any prohibited substances have been administered to horses.
- 8) Investigates applicants for licenses to conduct race meets and pari-mutuel wagering, including simulcasting facilities, and approves specific simulcasting agreements at each simulcast facility.
- 9) Collects and verifies funds submitted by tracks to the Track Distribution Fund and disburses the funds received to recipient tracks.
- 10) Designates official registrars for registration of mares and stallions, and certification of Nebraska-bred horses.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

The Nebraska State Racing Commission is a one-program agency. Our program objectives for FY 2017-2019 are to continue a regulatory enforcement program that provides necessary and adequate regulation of horseracing and pari-mutuel wagering at a level consistent with and adjusted to reflect the amount of live racing activities approved and to ensure that the industry is properly and adequately regulated.

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Investigations

The Racing Commission employs investigative personnel to perform background checks on license applications, investigate alleged violations of administrative rules and state statutes governing horse racing, and administer field testing to prevent and detect use of prohibited substances and alcohol. Commission investigators assist local and state law enforcement in matters involving race track operations and licensees, and coordinate the support of track security personnel. Due to funding issues the Commission has reduced its investigative staff to 2 part-time investigators.

During 2014, the Racing Commission investigators documented 47 cases involving, falsification of applications, disturbances, human drug testing, horse positive drug tests and case related to run of races. The investigators also investigated eight positive equine drug tests.

During calendar year 2015, the Racing Commission investigators documented 35 cases. These cases involved horse positive drug tests, human drug testing, disturbances, assaults and other rule violations. Investigators investigated three positive equine drug tests. These positive test were for tests involved class 4 and 5 drugs which are the lowest on the classes of drugs.

Equine Drug Testing

The Nebraska Racing Commission employs the service of a professional analytical laboratory of the purpose of testing urine and blood samples from horses, and for the identification of substances and residues that may be relevant to enforcement of rules and racing integrity. The Commission began directly contracting for testing services in June 2005. Prior to that time, race tracks would contract for services subject to Commission approval.
