

The purpose of the Board of Medical Radiography is to provide regulatory oversight for the occupation of Medical Radiography. Licensee's within this occupation include Medical Radiographers, Limited Medical Radiographers, Limited Computed Tomography Radiographers, Temporary Medical Radiographers, and Temporary Limited Computed Tomography Radiographers. During my appointment to the Board of Medical Radiography, I believe the Board has operated in a very effective and pragmatic manner.

The Board of Medical Radiography is comprised of four (4) Medical Radiographers and one (1) Limited Medical Radiographer. The Board has a track record for effectively working with department staff and department legal in a collaborative manner as to uphold the statutory requirements surrounding Medical Radiography without imposing any unjust or unwarranted sanctions that would create barriers for those wishing to practice in the field of Medical Radiography. The Board has a history of guiding and educating licensee's through the statutory requirements and only impugning those individuals that are in flagrant violation of the practice of Medical Radiography.

As the Chair of the Board of Medical Radiography, I have spent 10 years watching our Board operate in a fair, transparent, responsible, and equitable manner. As a whole, the Board of Medical Radiography understands that we have a statutory and fiduciary responsibility to the State of Nebraska and to those that seek healthcare in the our state. The Board also recognizes the responsibility it has to those holding a licensure for Radiography and takes deliberate steps to ensure that the practices observed by the Board are fair and equitable and that any punitive actions are proportionate to the infraction presented by the investigative division.
