Summary of purpose and/or changes: LB 34 establishes the State-Tribal Relations Committee as a special legislative committee. The Committee would meet as necessary to consider, study, monitor, and review legislation that impacts state-tribal relation issues and present draft legislation and policy recommendations to the appropriate standing committee.

The seven member committee would be appointed by the Executive Board from the membership of six designated standing committees. The Executive Board would also appoint the chairperson and vice-chairperson of the Committee.
