LB 421 allows an unlimited number of motor vehicles or trailers owned by a person to be issued Purple Heart specialty license plates.

The bill amends § 60-3,125 to state any number of motor vehicles or trailers owned by the applicant may be so licensed at any one time. Current law only allows for one vehicle to be so licensed.
