Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 442 would have amended section 77-2704.46, the sales tax exemption for agricultural commodities, seeds, and chemicals, to expand the definition of animal life exempt from tax. The current statute exempts animal life which ordinarily constitutes food for human consumption. LB 442 would have specifically included pheasants, quail and partridge. It was to be operative October 1, 2007.
