A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-376,
2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2006; to provide
3 for private party In Transit stickers; and to repeal the
4 original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-376, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2006, is amended to read:

3 60-376 (1) Subject to all the provisions of law relating
4 to motor vehicles and trailers not inconsistent with this section,
5 any motor vehicle dealer or trailer dealer who is regularly engaged
6 within this state in the business of buying and selling motor
7 vehicles and trailers, who regularly maintains within this state an
8 established place of business, and who desires to effect delivery
9 of any motor vehicle or trailer bought or sold by him or her from
10 the point where purchased or sold to points within or outside this
11 state may, solely for the purpose of such delivery by himself or
12 herself, his or her agent, or a bona fide purchaser, operate such
13 motor vehicle or tow such trailer on the highways of this state
14 without charge or registration of such motor vehicle or trailer.
15 A sticker shall be displayed on the front and rear windows or
16 the rear side windows of such motor vehicle, except a motorcycle,
17 and displayed on the front and rear of each such trailer. On the
18 sticker shall be plainly printed in black letters the words In
19 Transit. One In Transit sticker shall be displayed on a motorcycle,
20 which sticker may be one-half the size required for other motor
21 vehicles. Such stickers shall include a registration number, which
22 registration number shall be different for each sticker or pair of
23 stickers issued, and the contents of such sticker and the numbering
24 system shall be as prescribed by the department. Each dealer
25 issuing such stickers shall keep a record of the registration

1 number of each sticker or pair of stickers on the invoice of
2 such sale. Such sticker shall allow such owner to operate the
3 motor vehicle or tow such trailer for a period of thirty days
4 in order to effect proper registration of the new or used motor
5 vehicle or trailer. When any person, firm, or corporation has
6 had a motor vehicle or trailer previously registered and license
7 plates assigned to such person, firm, or corporation, such owner
8 may operate the motor vehicle or tow such trailer for a period of
9 thirty days in order to effect transfer of plates to the new or
10 used motor vehicle or trailer.

11 (2) An owner of a motor vehicle or trailer purchased from
12 a private party may post a visible notice on the motor vehicle or
13 trailer that indicates the date of purchase of the motor vehicle
14 or trailer and the owner's name. The notices are to be displayed
15 on the front and rear windows or the rear side windows of a motor
16 vehicle, on the rear of a motorcycle, and on the front and rear of
17 a trailer. Such notice shall allow such owner to operate the motor
18 vehicle or tow the trailer for a period of thirty days in order to
19 effect proper registration of the motor vehicle or trailer.

20 (3) Upon demand of proper authorities, there shall be
21 presented by the person in charge of such motor vehicle or trailer,
22 for examination, a duly executed bill of sale therefor, a duly
23 assigned certificate of title, or other satisfactory evidence of
24 the right of possession by such person of such motor vehicle or
25 trailer.
