The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Currently, there are rules that prohibit a high school student athlete from participating and competing in high school and in club for the same sport during the same season.

LB 1135 seeks to prohibit the adopting of rules that bind the high school student athlete from participating, training and competing in their high school sport in addition to a club sport as recognized by the US Olympic Committee for the same type of sport during the same season.
