

LEGISLATIVE BILL 328A

Approved by the Governor May 30, 2007

Introduced by Synowiecki, 7

FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 328, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$6,000 from the General Fund for FY2007-08 to the Public Employees Retirement Board, for Program 41, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 328, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated \$4,260 from the State Employees Defined Contribution Retirement Expense Fund and \$1,740 from the County Employees Defined Contribution Retirement Expense Fund for FY2007-08 to the Public Employees Retirement Board, for Program 41, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 328, One Hundredth Legislature, First Session, 2007.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
