A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to state government; to amend section 84-602,
 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for
 the establishment of a web site known as the Taxpayer
 Transparency Act; to provide powers and duties for the
 State Treasurer; and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The establishment of the web site provided for

- 2 <u>in section 84-602 and described in section 3 of this act shall be</u>
- 3 known and may be cited as the Taxpayer Transparency Act.
- 4 Sec. 2. Section 84-602, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 5 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 6 84-602 It shall be the duty of the State Treasurer:
- 7 (1) To receive and keep all money of the state not
- 8 expressly required to be received and kept by some other person;
- 9 (2) To disburse the public money upon warrants drawn upon
- 10 the state treasury according to law_T and not otherwise;
- 11 (3) To keep a just, true, and comprehensive account of
- 12 all money received and disbursed;
- 13 (4) To keep a just account with each fund, and each head
- 14 of appropriation made by law, and the warrants drawn against them;
- 15 (5) To render a full statement to the Department of
- 16 Administrative Services, of all money received by him or her from
- 17 whatever source, and if on account of revenue, for what year;
- 18 of all penalties and interest on delinquent taxes reported or
- 19 accounted for to him or her, and of all disbursements of public
- 20 funds; with a list, in numerical order, of all warrants redeemed,
- 21 the name of the payee, amount, interest, and total amount allowed
- 22 thereon, and with the amount of the balance of the several funds
- 23 unexpended; which statement shall be made on the first day of
- 24 December, March, June, and September, and more often if required;
- 25 (6) To report to the Legislature as soon as practicable,

1 but within ten days after the commencement of each regular session,

- 2 a detailed statement of the condition of the treasury, and its
- 3 operations for the preceding fiscal year;
- 4 (7) To give information in writing to the Legislature,
- 5 whenever required, upon any subject connected with the treasury or
- 6 touching any duty of his or her office; and
- 7 (8) To account for, and pay over, all money received by
- 8 him or her as such treasurer, to his or her successor in office,
- 9 and deliver all books, vouchers, and effects of office to him or
- 10 her; and such successor shall receipt therefor. In accounting for
- 11 and paying over such money the treasurer shall not be held liable
- 12 on account of any loss occasioned by any investment, when such
- 13 investment shall have been made pursuant to the direction of the
- 14 state investment officer; and.
- 15 (9) To develop and maintain a single, searchable web
- 16 site with information on state tax receipts and expenditures which
- 17 <u>is accessible by the public at no cost to access as provided in</u>
- 18 section 3 of this act. The web site shall be hosted on a server
- 19 owned and operated by the State of Nebraska or approved by the
- 20 Chief Information Officer. The naming convention for the web site
- 21 shall identify the web site as a state government web site. The web
- 22 site shall not include the treasurer's name, the treasurer's image,
- 23 the treasurer's seal, or a welcome message.
- 24 Sec. 3. (1)(a) Not later than January 1, 2010, the web
- 25 site established, developed, and maintained by the State Treasurer

1 pursuant to subdivision (9) of section 84-602 shall provide such

- 2 information as will document the sources of all tax receipts
- 3 and the expenditure of state funds by all agencies, boards,
- 4 commissions, and departments of the state.
- 5 (b) The State Treasurer shall, in appropriate detail,
- 6 cause to be published on the web site:
- 7 (i) The identity, principal location, and amount of funds
- 8 received or expended by the State of Nebraska and all of its
- 9 agencies, boards, commissions, and departments;
- 10 (ii) The funding or expending agency, board, commission,
- 11 or department;
- 12 <u>(iii) The budget program source;</u>
- 13 (iv) The amount, date, purpose, and recipient of all
- 14 disbursed funds; and
- 15 (v) Such other relevant information as will further
- 16 the intent of enhancing the transparency of state government
- 17 financial operations to its citizens and taxpayers. The web site
- 18 shall include data for fiscal year 2008-09 and each fiscal year
- 19 thereafter.
- 20 (2) Beginning July 1, 2010, the data shall be available
- 21 on the web site no later than thirty days after the end of
- 22 the preceding fiscal year. All agencies, boards, commissions, and
- 23 departments of the state shall provide to the State Treasurer, at
- 24 such times and in such form as designated by the State Treasurer,
- 25 such information as is necessary to accomplish the purposes of the

1 Taxpayer Transparency Act. Nothing in this subsection requires the

- 2 disclosure of information which is considered confidential under
- 3 state or federal law or is not a public record under section
- 4 84-712.05.
- 5 (3)(a) For purposes of this section, expenditure of state
- 6 funds means all expenditures of appropriated or nonappropriated
- 7 funds by an agency, board, commission, or department of the state
- 8 from the state treasury in forms including, but not limited to:
- 9 <u>(i) Grants;</u>
- 10 (ii) Contracts;
- 11 (iii) Subcontracts;
- 12 (iv) State aid to political subdivisions; and
- 13 (v) Tax refunds or credits that may be disclosed
- 14 pursuant to the Nebraska Advantage Act, the Nebraska Advantage
- 15 Microenterprise Tax Credit Act, the Nebraska Advantage Research and
- 16 <u>Development Act, or the Nebraska Advantage Rural Development Act.</u>
- 17 (b) Expenditure of state funds does not include the
- 18 transfer of funds between two agencies, boards, commissions, or
- 19 departments of the state or payments of state or federal assistance
- 20 to an individual.
- 21 Sec. 4. Original section 84-602, Reissue Revised Statutes
- 22 of Nebraska, is repealed.
