1 Section 1. Section 28-1212.04, Revised Statutes

- 2 Supplement, 2009, is amended to read:
- 3 28-1212.04 Any person, within the territorial boundaries
- 4 of any city, incorporated village, of the first class or county
- 5 containing a city of the metropolitan class or primary class, who
- 6 unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally or recklessly discharges
- 7 a firearm, while in any motor vehicle or in the proximity of
- 8 any motor vehicle that such person has just exited, at or in the
- 9 general direction of any person, dwelling, building, structure,
- 10 occupied motor vehicle, occupied aircraft, inhabited motor home as
- 11 defined in section 71-4603, or inhabited camper unit as defined in
- 12 section  $60-1801_{7}$  is guilty of a Class IC felony.
