- LB 489 (*Cornett*) Authorize municipalities to receive sales tax information
- LB 963 (*Pahls*) Change provisions relating to banking and finance
- LB 613 (*Pirsch*) Change certain lien provisions relating to homeowner's associations and condominiums
- LB 729 (*Mello*) Provide powers to an authority and change bond provisions under the Community Development Law
- LB 1070 (*Wightman*) Change eligibility provisions for petitioning on the general election ballot
- LB 1035 (*Sullivan*) Provide for automatic nomination of airport authority board members as prescribed
- LB 810 (*Gloor*) Prohibit insurance policy provisions relating to fees for dental services
- LB 896 (*Fischer*) Change motor vehicle industry regulations
- LB 898 (*Fischer*) Redefine minitruck for vehicle titling, registration, and insurance statutes and rules of the road
- LB 928 (*Louden*) Provide for mountain lion hunting permits
- LB 803 (*Lautenbaugh*) Require presentment of an operator's license and proof of insurance to a peace officer by a driver involved in an accident and mandate impoundment of the vehicle in certain situations
