Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1007 adds a new provision regarding production of certain reports so that when a state agency, board or commission or other public entity is required to provide a report to the Legislature, the report must include the estimated cost, including staff time, to produce the report.

The bill then adds a requirement that the list of reports periodically prepared and distributed to all senators by the Clerk of the Legislature would include the estimated cost of the production of each report as stated on such report.
