Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Under current law, a keno operator must wait 5 minutes in between keno games. LB 1067 would allow a county, city or village to choose a different time between 5 and 1 minutes.

Explanation of amendments:

AM1961 changes the range of time between keno games that can be set by cities, counties or villages. The bill creates the range between one and five minutes. AM1961 changes the range to between three and five minutes.
