Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 151 is introduced on behalf of the Workers' Compensation Court. Current law specifies that the court must maintain offices in the State Capitol. LB 151 removes this requirement. LB 151 additionally allows telephonic and videoconferencing for nonevidentiary hearings and evidentiary hearings if stipulated by the parties.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment amends section 48-153 by removing language requiring judges to reside in Lancaster County unless the court approves residence outside Lancaster County. The amendment additionally incorporates principles from LB 238 and LB 346. LB 238 removes the three judge panel appellate procedure and LB 346 provides the court with contempt powers.
