Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 618 would amend section 28-1204.04 (Unlawful possession of a firearm at a school ...) of the Nebraska Statutes to provide that a peace officer or other authorized law enforcement officer may possess a firearm on school grounds and in school buildings when providing security at a school or at a school event, either under contract, or by request for security by school officials.

Explanation of amendments:

* Strikes on page 2, beginning on line 13 with the word "to" through the word "district" in line 14 and

* Inserts "by a school" in the place of the stricken language to clarify that both "public" and "private" schools that contract with off-duty police officers may have those officers carry a firearm while providing contract services.
