**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 700 changes boundaries of the public service commissioner districts by the adoption of maps by reference.

The state is divided into five public service commissioner districts. The overall range of deviation is approximately 4 percent. Districts are drawn using census geography and population data from the 2010 US census.

The maps will be kept on file in the Secretary of State's office.

LB 700 includes the emergency clause.
