**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 807 would amend 69-2433; subsection 8, by striking the words "no violations" to clarify that the only dis-qualifiers against obtaining a concealed handgun under the Nebraska Concealed Handgun Permit Act shall be a conviction of either a felony or misdemeanor offense. (This change will clarify the legislature's intent as to what convictions shall be automatic dis-qualifiers for obtaining a Concealed Handgun Permit, which currently is an issue being litigated, and passage of this bill will provide the judicial branch with clear direction from the Legislature.)
