Summary of purpose and/or changes:

At the primary election in May 2012, voters would be given the opportunity to amend Article III, section 12, pertaining to term limits for members of the Legislature. The amendment would clarify that a member is considered to have served for one-half of a term if he or she serves for a period beginning on the first day of session in an odd-number year through the first day of session in the following odd-numbered year.
