LB 1090 provides for the State Department of Education (NDE) to award grants to service institutions for nonrecurring expenses incurred in initiating or expanding services under the Summer Food Service Program. Annual grants of up to \$15,000 per site are to be awarded on a competitive basis up to a total of \$140,000 per fiscal year. The bill defines service institutions eligible for grants and gives preference to certain service institutions. Grant recipients must assure that grant funds are used to supplement state and local resources currently used to fund the school breakfast program or Summer Food Service Program.

NDE is required to administer the grant program and submit an annual report to the Education Committee of the Legislature detailing the number of grant awards, sites, service institutions funded, and children served. NDE indicates the department will assign a .3 FTE Program Specialist to administer the grant program. The existing staff person is funded with child nutrition funds at an estimated cost of \$22,320 of federal fund expenditures in 2012-13 and \$23,250 in FY2013-14. No additional federal funds will be received by the state to fund the grant program. Annual grants will total \$140,000 of general funds. Grant recipients may include political subdivisions such as schools, cities, or counties or higher education entities which offer summer food service programs.
