This bill would change the salary of Supreme Court judges. This change would also alter the salaries of the judges of the Court of Appeals, the District Court, the Separate Juvenile Court, the Workers Compensation Court, and the County Court as these salaries are a percent of the salary of the Supreme Court judges. The bill has the emergency clause.

The bill currently states that the following:

On July 1, 2012, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be XXX dollars.

Because there is no dollar amount set for the salaries, this bill has an indeterminate fiscal impact. The fiscal impact can be determined when a dollar amount is set.
